DATE: February 6, 2013

This morning at approximately 11:30 a.m., a bomb threat was called in to the Lee County High School front office. School district personnel immediately began a planned safety response.

- Students were evacuated from both Lee County Middle and Lee County High School to a safe location.
- Restrooms were available for all students.
- District staff cooperated with state, city, and county police personnel to secure both buildings.
- Upon recommendation of the Kentucky State Police, all schools were dismissed early.
- A bomb detection dog was brought to the site.
- Both schools were thoroughly searched, secured and deemed safe.
- Lee County Schools will return to regular schedule tomorrow, Thursday, February 7, 2013.

The Kentucky State Police are in charge of the on-going investigation regarding today's bomb threat. I would like to thank state, city, and county police officers for their prompt response. I would also like to thank Lee County School personnel and students for the calm and efficient manner in which they carried out the district's safety response plan.
