He established a student advisory council to encourage student input and increase student ownership in learning. In addition, Superintendent Evans has made it his personal mission to facilitate the growth and development of each and every student. He is

continually helping school leaders, teachers, support personnel, parents, and the community be successful in their respective roles. He truly knows the importance each school employee plays in providing an excellent education for Lee County students.

In realizing communication as a key to success for all students, Superintendent Evans established a communication committee to develop a District Communication Plan which would facilitate a common focus for all staff. Superintendent Evans also started a monthly district, parent, and community breakfast held at the central

Superintendent Evans works hard to keep up with the rapid pace of change in order to ensure a culture of continuous improvement for himself, Lee County Students, staff and the community. Most recently Lee County Schools was a recipient of the Born Learning Grant to bring the resources and tools that will help connect children to success in early childhood even before they begin the formal learning process.
